1. African-American senior attending a Northwest Suburban High School
  - *Northwest Suburban communities include: Algonquin, Arlington Heights, Barrington, Bartlett, Buffalo Grove, Carol Stream, Crystal Lake, Elgin, Elk Grove, Hanover Park, Hoffman Estates, Huntley, Lake in the Hills, Platine, Rolling Meadows, Roselle, Schaumburg and Streamwood*
2. Completed application form – typed or neatly hand printed.
3. High school transcript (minimum of 3.0 grade point average on a scale of 4.0 is required).
  - If an unofficial transcript is given, the school counselor verification page **MUST** be filled out and signed by a school counselor verifying grade point average. Unofficial transcripts that are **NOT** signed by a school counselor will disqualify applicant.
4. Typed Essay – 2 pages, 12 pt. font, and double-spaced.
5. One personal reference letter.
6. One academic reference letter.
7. Picture of applicant donating canned goods to a local food pantry or clothes to a shelter.
8. Finalist interview with scholarship committee.
